

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Activity Haven (AH) is actively recruiting for an Executive Director to lead their team in Peterborough, ON. AH is a Seniors' Recreation Centre that offers recreational, instructional and leisure programs to people aged 50+ from Peterborough and surrounding area. It was founded in 1975 by some sixty retirees and operated in co-operation with the City of Peterborough Recreation Division and the Ministry of Community Services. Membership has grown steadily over the past 44 years to approximately 1,300 in 2019. The annual operating budget is approximately \$500,000. Donations are an integral part of supporting the ongoing operation.

Reporting to the Board of Directors, the Executive Director is the leader and public face of AH, responsible for the implementation and administration of the programs, policies, finances and property of the centre, within the guidelines established by the Board of Directors.

Working with others as a leader and as a partner, the Executive Director will continue to encourage engagement of staff and volunteers who provide a full range of programs and services for seniors in the community. An important part of the role will be establishing relationships with other agencies and financial partners at the municipal, provincial and federal level.
